“Sing4Me” is a consortium of non-profit barbershop choruses in the Twin Cities representing the Barbershop Harmony Society and Sweet Adelines International. Proceeds go to support activities of their respective chapters – performances during the year at nursing homes, retirement communities, parades, and the Youth in Harmony program which fosters the love of singing among young people and through the music education programs in schools.

FURTHER DETAIL

Quartets will be available to perform for that someone special in your life on February 14. Performances can be scheduled from 8am-9pm within a four-hour window. Shorter windows are available for an additional fee. We have been delivering Live Singing Valentines since 1980. Valentines have been presented in offices/places of work, school classrooms, nursing homes, hospitals, construction sites, and any other location you can imagine. There are tears, laughter, red faces, and applause, but most of all, there is love in the air when four guys or gals show up in matching outfits with card in hand, big smiles, and pitch pipe at the ready! The card is presented, a member of the quartet announces “Valentine greetings from _____ do we bring, now here’s what they asked us to sing...!” With that the quartet sings 2 appropriate love songs like “Let Me Call You Sweetheart” or “The Story of the Rose.” That’s usually when the tears come, and sometimes not just from the Valentines recipient! Everyone enjoys a good love song. For those wanting a longer program, we can provide a 5-6 song 20-minute package.
